The family of Giovanni S. Calabro, Sr. recently purchased three Topaz Desktop Video Magnifiers to assist Bristol and Farmington residents with severe vision concerns. A \$6,800 donation was made to the Bristol Lions Low Vision Center in memory of Mr. Calabro.

Residents afflicted with Macular Degeneration, diabetic eye disease and eye injuries often lose a significant portion of their eyesight. These particular machines magnify print materials to allow a greater independent level of living. Users are able to read their favorite book,

newspaper or magazine in large-print font.

"These devices often spell the difference between being able to function in an everyday fashion with a significant loss of vision or being dependent on others to view one's world," stated V. Everett Lyons, First Vice-President of the Bristol Lions. "We are delighted that the family of Giovanni S. Calabro Sr. chose to honor his memory and to recognize his concern for others by making this donation in support of our efforts in the area of eye sight."

Santo Calabro, the oldest son, stated, "My father, a respected tailor at the Farmington Tailor Shop in Farmington, CT, wore his eye glasses as a young man and throughout his life while altering many clothes for his loyal customers. My dad empathized with those individuals who needed eye glasses so he would donate his spare lenses to the Bristol Lions Club.
